Face Masks—Now Required by state and city.

Wear a face covering that covers your nose and mouth to help protect others in case you're infected with COVID-19 but don't have symptoms.

Who should NOT use cloth face coverings: children under age 2, or anyone who has trouble breathing, is unconscious, incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance. Wash your hands before putting on your face covering. Make sure you can breathe easily. Don't put the face covering around your neck or up on your forehead. Don't touch the face covering, and, if you do, wash your hands or use hand sanitizer to disinfect. Handle only by the ear loops or ties. Be careful not to touch your eyes, nose, and mouth when removing and wash hands immediately after removing. (From the CDC Website)

- The **National Alliance on Mental Illness-MN** is holding many online classes and seminars. Obtain information about mental illnesses, treatments, crisis management, suicide prevention, the mental health system and local resources along with practical strategies for helping a loved one or friend. This includes learning the LEAP strategy for improving communication; Listen, Empathize, Agree-on what you can, and Partner. It is a six-hour workshop for family and friends of a teen or adult living with a mental illness and people living with a mental illness who are doing well in their recovery. Next session is **Thursday, August 13 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:45 p.m.** Check out their website, www.namimn.org, for other sessions on suicide prevention, depression and more!
- The **National Alliance on Mental Illness-MN** invites families with children ages ten and up to register now for the **online screening of the documentary *Angst* at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 25.** This event will feature a viewing of the 56-minute film, followed by an informative panel discussion led by experts in the children's mental health field. Through candid interviews, the makers of *Angst* tell the stories of many kids and teens who discuss their anxiety and its impacts on their lives and relationships. The film also includes a special interview with Michael Phelps, a mental health advocate and one of the greatest athletes of all time. While *Angst* documents the struggles some people have with anxiety, it also reveals their hope for the future. Noah, a teenager in the film, describes it this way: "Anxiety doesn't define me.
