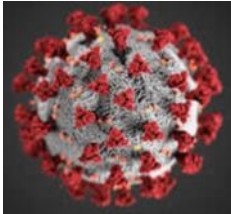
died on Monday, June 8 at the age of 94. She was a Bethel member and organist.

## **There will be a Special Congregational Meeting Sunday, June 21, 2020 @ 10:00 a.m.**

For the sole purpose to discuss and vote on the recommendation of the Finance Committee Church Council to increase the 2020 budget by \$50,000 to pay to repair and replace the roof.

*From the March 10 Council Minutes:*

*Roof Estimate and Special Congregational Meeting: The Finance Committee has contacted four roofing companies. Wagner Building gave an estimate, Swan Lake looked at the church but has not submitted any numbers and is booked out for this year, Bemidji Roofing flat out refused and Husky Roofing said they would look, but have not, to the knowledge of the office. The Wagner quote is for \$150,000, \$50,000 over the budgeted amount. At 10% of the total budget this requires a special congregational meeting.*
