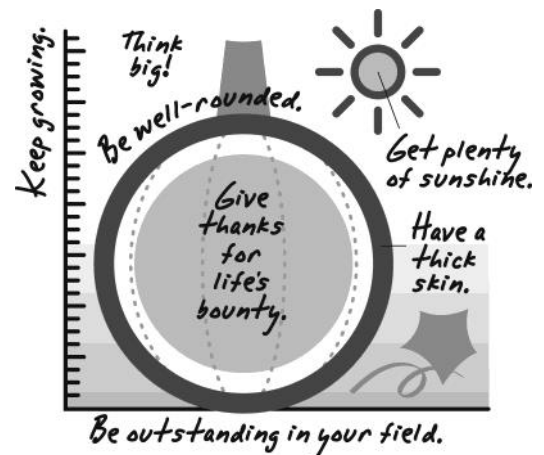

Wondering if you should stay home?

Get tested for COVID-19?

If you, or a member of your household, can answer yes to any of the following,

Face Masks—Now Required by state and city.

Wear a face covering that covers your nose and mouth to help protect others in case you're infected with COVID-19 but don't have symptoms.

Who should NOT use cloth face coverings: children under age 2, or anyone who has trouble breathing, is unconscious, incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance. Wash your hands before putting on your face covering. Make sure you can breathe easily. Don't put the face covering around your neck or up on your forehead.

Don't touch the face covering, and, if you do, wash your hands or use hand sanitizer to disinfect. Handle only by the ear loops or ties. Be careful not to touch your eyes, nose, and mouth when removing and wash hands immediately after removing. (From the CDC Website)

COVID-19 at Bethel Update

Thanks to the congregation for its understanding during the cancellation. We are happy to report that the member who tested positive for COVID had a mild case and is out of isolation!

As a reminder, the latest CDC rules are to stay isolated for 10 days following onset of symptoms, or a positive test, and at least 24 hours with no fever. Those who have had close contact should quarantine for 14 days. Close contact means you were within 6 feet of someone who has COVID-19 for a total of 15 minutes or more, or you had direct physical contact with the person (hugged or kissed them). So, as long as no symptoms developed (see above) the congregation at large is also clear now!
