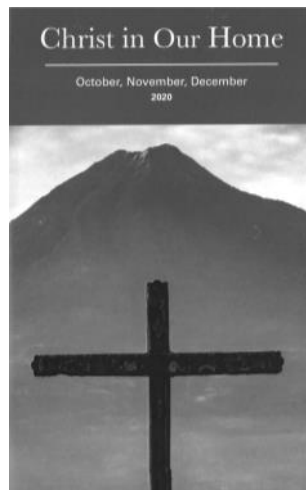

**Face Masks—Now Required by state and city.**

Wear a face covering that covers your nose and mouth to help protect others in case you're infected with COVID-19 but don't have symptoms.

*Who should NOT use cloth face coverings:* children under age 2, or anyone who has trouble breathing, is unconscious, incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance. Wash your hands before putting on your face covering. Make sure you can breathe easily. Don't put the face covering around your neck or up on your forehead.

**Don't touch the face covering, and, if you do, wash your hands or use hand sanitizer to disinfect. Handle only by the ear loops or ties. Be careful not to touch your eyes, nose, and mouth when removing and wash hands immediately after removing.** (From the CDC Website)
