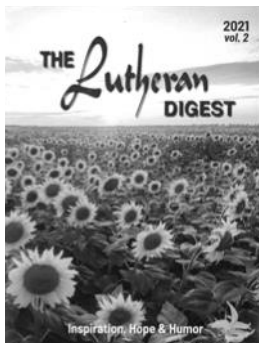

office. No extra trip needed!

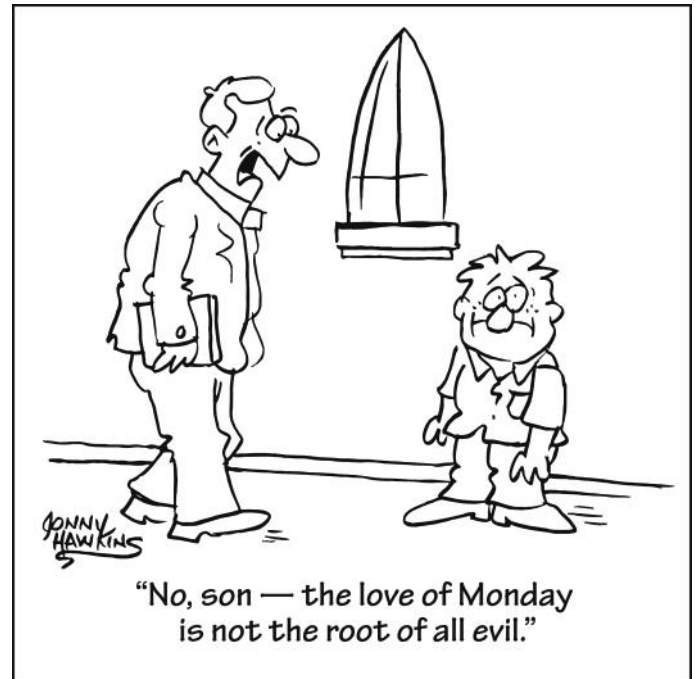
