- **New loss of smell or taste?**



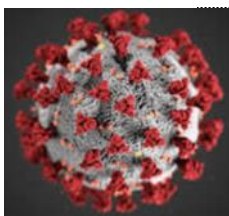

### COVID-19 Vaccine in Minnesota

Those who are most vulnerable will be vaccinated first, followed closely by those slightly less vulnerable, and so on. We are currently in Phase 1a, which is for health care workers and long-term care residents. Phase 1b will expand vaccination to adults aged 75+ and frontline essential workers, and Phase 1c will further open eligibility to include adults aged 65-74, adults aged 16-64 with high-risk medical conditions, and other essential workers.
