In explanation, May expenses jumped by ~\$6,000 from April due to: 1) three payrolls (~\$2,180), 2) Sally McIntyre going FT, (~\$1,253) and 3) the Annual Storm Water Fee to the city was paid (\$2,438.52). If we keep up with our pledges and other budgeted income and encounter only our average expenses, we will not go further into deficit!
