Bethel COVID-19 Update

Church services are not affected by the current Minnesota 'Pause'. Only receptions and social hours are banned. Please continue to exercise social distancing practices during service, and especially communion!

If you receive a positive COVID test and attended church in the 3 days prior to symptom onset, please contact Pastor Kindem or Sally!

As a reminder, the latest CDC rules are to stay isolated for 10 days following onset of symptoms, or a positive test, and at least 24 hours with no fever. Those who have had close contact should quarantine for 14 days. Close contact means you were within 6 feet of someone who has COVID-19 for a total of 15 minutes or more, or you had direct physical contact with the person (hugged or kissed them).

Face Masks

Now Required by state and city.

Wear a face covering that covers your nose and mouth to help protect others in case you're infected with COVID-19 but don't have symptoms.

Who should NOT use cloth face coverings: children under age 2, or anyone who has trouble breathing, is unconscious, incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance. Wash your hands before putting on your face covering. Make sure you can breathe easily. Don't put the face covering around your neck or up on your forehead.

Don't touch the face covering, and, if you do, wash your hands or use hand sanitizer to disinfect.

Handle only by the ear loops or ties. Be careful not to touch your eyes, nose, and mouth when removing and wash hands immediately after removing. (From the CDC Website)
